Workshop ISO 19011:2011 Guidelines for Auditing Management System Seafood Supply Chain

Terra Moana and Seafood Matter are strategic partners working to improve seafood sector social conditions through developing and applying a unique *Seafood Sector Social Footprint Scoring Framework* for use onboard fishing vessels and which incorporates aspects from ILOC188, ILOC183, SA8000, the Marine Stewardship Council labour requirements, the Environmental Justice Foundation 10 Principles for Transparency and the NGO Framework for Social Responsibility in the Seafood Sector (Certification and Ratings Collaboration). It was tested with Austral Fisheries Ltd.

They are partnering with Social Accountability International (SAI) to deliver SA8000 training in Wellington, New Zealand in October 2019. ISO19011:2011* training is the next step in building capability within the seafood sector to develop robust internal systems and prepare for external audit, and will be delivered in Melbourne, Australia, 25-26 November 2019.

The training workshop will detail the importance of ISO19011:2011 for internal, second party or third-party audit. It will review the entire audit process with a focus on audit in fisheries and at processing sites to ensure a shared understanding of the key elements in the audit process and the need for auditors and assessors to use the steps in each audit process. The training will also address ISO19011:2018 aspects related to risk in auditing.

The workshop will provide participants with the knowledge and skills needed to assess and report on conformity and effective process implementation (in accordance with ISO 19011:2011), including quality management system continual improvement. ISO19011:2011 currently is a pre-requisite for auditor competence in auditing certification programs like MSC and ASC.

The training workshop is open to other sectors.

**The American Society for Quality notes that ISO 19011:2011 is defined as the standard that sets forth guidelines for auditing management systems. The standard contains guidance on managing an audit program, the principles of auditing, and the evaluation of individuals responsible for managing the audit programs. An audit program consists of the arrangements made to complete all the individual audits needed to achieve a specific purpose.*
