SA8000® STANDARD Introduction and Basic Auditor Training Course

The SA8000® is the leading social certification standard for factories and organisations across the globe. It was established by Social Accountability International 1997 as a multi-stakeholder initiative. The Standard is an overall framework to enable certified organisations to demonstrate their fair treatment of workers across industries and in any country.

SA8000 measures social performance in eight areas important to social accountability in workplaces, anchored by a complete management system that drives continuous improvement. It is appreciated by brands and industry leaders for its rigorous approach to ensuring the highest quality of social compliance in their supply chains, whilst not sacrificing business interests.

Terra Moana's mission is grounded in natural capital "know how" and recognition of the need to regenerate human and natural systems. This is predicated on a respect for, and understanding of, the multiple factors that must be considered to enable wise stewardship of natural resources and the communities reliant upon them. We can support teams, executives, divisions and individuals to do the right thing. Terra Moana is building capability in Social Accountability in the fishing sector.

Terra Moana has partnered with Seafood Matter, a leading seafood social accountability audit and assessment company to develop a unique Seafood Sector Social Footprint Scoring Framework for use onboard fishing vessels and incorporating the standards aspirations from ILOC188, ILOC183, SA8000, the Marine Stewardship Council and the NGO Framework for Social Responsibility in the Seafood Sector (Certification and Ratings Collaboration).

Terra Moana is partnering with Social Accountability International to offer SA8000 training in New Zealand that is open not only to those seeking to become certified auditors but also anyone interested in social compliance and auditing. This will equip participants with knowledge of the latest auditing techniques with a special focus on the **SA8000** Standard for decent work. Successful completion of the course does not automatically qualify one as an SA8000 Team or Lead auditor as there are other requirements that must be met.
